



History

Little Women began in 1996 – the vision of two moms who wanted something “more” for their young daughters. Through the years the ministry has focused on different – yet connected – aspects of young womanhood. From the godly woman described in Proverbs 31 – “A woman of noble character, who can find? She is worth far more than rubies...” to LOVE – as found in Corinthians.

The program has grown through the years from the first small group of 18 girls to over 80! They serve the neighborhood, the church and the community through service projects, such as stuffing stockings for Operation Christmas or decorating food baskets at Thanksgiving. During Valentine’s they work carefully to create special valentines.

As a group they have traveled to other churches in our area to share their ministry and sing; they’ve traveled to an Amish farm in Northern Pennsylvania to Central Virginia and a Country Barn on retreats. They’ve stayed in elegant hotel suites to learn the fine art of cooking and they’ve slept in sleeping bags on the floor to enjoy nature!
