

WHITE WATER RAFTING TRIP INFO

Thanks to all the planning work by Tim Millman, we are now ready to start the registration process for the trip. We still have a few details to fill in here, but we wanted to get this out to you QUICKLY since September will be here before we know it and we REALLY need to get registrations done quickly. The following is some basic info about the trip...

When: Friday/Saturday, 10-11 September 2009. The location is roughly 4-5 hours away in West Virginia, so our plan is to carpool/vanpool out to the location on Friday afternoon, enjoy some fellowship time on Friday evening, and then be ready to raft bright & early on Saturday. The adventure will take most of the day, but we'll get everyone home on Saturday evening.

Where: We'll be using "Class VI" outfitters in Lansing, WV. Their website is www.class-vi.com – you can check there for more info. The trip will be down the Upper Gauley River. During weekends in September & October, they release water from the dams up river, so there will be plenty of challenging rapids to navigate!

Who: The trip is open to anyone from Cedar Run and any guests you'd like to invite. Rafters must be 15 years old! Anyone who is under 18 years of age will need to have a parent or guardian sign the release form for them.

Cost: The cost for the rafting trip and the motel room for Friday night (double occupancy) is \$214.76. There will also be some incidental expenses such as food on the way out and back, and probably a contribution to gasoline for the drivers. The outfitter will provide lunch during the rafting trip. If the price is prohibitive for anyone, please contact Bill Hite or Mark Seager and we'll work something out for you.

How to Register: If you're ready to commit to the trip, follow the steps below to register. These rafting tours fill up quickly, so we want to make sure we have as many as possible registered early!

1. Call Class VI at 1-800-252-7784 and tell them you'd like to register. You'll need to provide our Reservation Number (22248). They'll take your credit card information and you'll be set.
2. To help things to smoothly on the day of the rafting adventure, it will be helpful if you complete the pre-registration form as well. You can do this by going to their website (www.class-vi.com). Once on their home page, select the "PreTrip Registration" tab which is in the middle of the page on the far right side. You'll need the Reservation Number and the Group Leader Number for this form as well.
3. If you want to take a look at the Release Form that you'll be required to sign before heading down the river, you can find it under the "Guest Services" tab (top of the home page on the far right) and then selecting "Downloads" from the list on the left, and then selecting "[Download our authorized Whitewater Rafting liability forms here.](#)"
4. Drop Bill Hite (bill.hite@cox.net) and Tim Millman (tmillman@fidelityengineering.com) an e-mail letting us know you've registered so we can keep tabs on how many people we have.
