We all have a desire to be Wise.

Earthly wisdom verse Godly Wisdom

- Earthly wisdom appeals to the senses and emotions.
 - Wisdom of God <u>reflects him</u>.
- Earthly wisdom says always follow your heart
 - Godly wisdom tells us in Jeremiah 17:9 <u>The heart is deceitful above all</u> things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?
- · Earthly wisdom says seeing is believing
 - Godly wisdom tells us in John 20:29 Blessed are this who have not seen yet believe
- Earthly wisdom says love your family and friends,
 - Godly wisdom tells us in Matthew 5:43-47 to also love your enemies and bless them.
- · Earthly wisdom says there are many ways to God
 - Godly Wisdom in Acts 4:12 tells us there is only one way to God, Jesus Christ.

8 Characteristics of Godly Wisdom from James 3.

- Humble Wise people don't constantly brag, boast, or display a prideful attitude.
- 2. Good deeds Wise people live an upright and moral life.
- 3. **Gentle** Wise people treat others with care and respect.
- Considerate Wise people put needs of others ahead of themselves when possible.
- Peace Loving Wise people don't foster division, instead the work to end strife and turmoil

- Merciful Wise people demonstrate compassion, forgiveness, and kindness to others.
- 7. <u>Sincere</u> Wise people are genuine, real and honest; not deceitful, hypercritical or false.
- 8. <u>Impartial</u> Wise people are fair and just. They do not show partiality to others for their own benefit.

Integrity

- A. A person of integrity is: <u>upright, straight, level, honest, sincere.</u>
- B. A person of integrity has a regard for what is Honorable not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men. 2 Cor. 8:21

Integrity is rooted

- 1. in a conscious Awareness of God. Psalm 139
- 2. Understanding that what is in my **Heart** will be lived out. Luke 6:45
- 3. Integrity is a goal of scripture education. 1 Timothy 1:3-7

What does the bible say about integrity?

- Integrity means treating people fairly and honestly Lev. 19:35-36; Duet.
 25:15; Prov. 16:11-13
- 2. Integrity is giving your word and keeping it. Exodus 8:28-32
- 3. Integrity will protect you. Psalm 25... David prays that integrity and uprightness will protect him. Psalm 25:21; Prov. 2:7-8; 10:9; 11:3
- 4. Integrity is more valuable than riches. Prov. 28:6
- 5. The Lord will test and Judge our integrity. 1 Chron. 29:17; Psalm 7:8
- 6. The Lord hates lies and lack of integrity. Zech. 8:16-17
- 7. It may be difficult to maintain your integrity. Job 2:3; 2:9; Prov. 29:10
- 8. Your character can be corrupted by bad company. 1 Cor. 15:33
- 9. Integrity will be rewarded. 1 Kins 9:4-5; Nehem. 7:2; Psalm 41:11-12
- 10. Your integrity should set an example. Titus 2:7

Benefits of Integrity

- 1. God looks for people of integrity. Psalm 15, 2 Chron. 16:9
- 2. No skeletons in the <u>closet</u> to worry about.
- 3. Freedom
- 4. A good name" (Prov. 22:1) and a Godly legacy (Prov. 20:7)

What does a person of integrity look like, is there a banner to identify them?

- 1. They value other peoples time
- 2. They give credit where it is due
- 3. They are authentic
- 4. They are always honest.
- 5. They never take advantage of others
- 6. They give people the benefit of the doubt
- 7. They do not argue over disagreements
- 8. They know when something is bothering someone
- 9. They believe others
- 10. They apologize first
- 11. They are humble
- 12. They do good whenever possible
- 13. They are always kind to those who need it

Decision Making

- Direction from God As Christians our overall direction in life is determined by our commitment to God.
 - That which God wants
 - What we would <u>want</u> if we had all the <u>facts</u>.
- 2. What is it we know to be the will of God?
 - Salvation of all men John 6:38-40, 2 Peter 3:9

- Maturity of Believers Hebrews 5:11 6:3
- Our obedience in every matter John 4:34-38
- Unity of believers John 17:20-23
- Moral Purity 1 Thess. 4:3-8
- Thankfulness 1 Thess. 5:16-18

How do we start in this decision making and what does the bible tell us?

- 1. Begin with prayer.
- 2. Does God already have a <u>clear teaching</u> about this
- 3. Define the <u>issue</u>, wise decisions are informed decisions.
- 4. Trust the Lord with your with your decision .
- 5. Be willing to <u>admit mistakes</u> and adjust accordingly.
- 6. Give praises to God for your success

There are <u>barriers</u> to finding God's will in your decision making.

- <u>Seeking</u> God's will over seeking God.
- Sin in our lives, have you sought forgiveness?
- Personal <u>blind spots</u>
- Trying to force God into giving a miraculous sign.
- Does God have a specific will? yes, but it <u>God's</u> duty to reveal it, Rom. 1:10;
 15:32; 1 Cor. 4:19; 16:7; James 4:13-15

<u>Pursue God, and the knowledge of his will will follow. We cannot expect to follow his will if we do not know him.</u>
