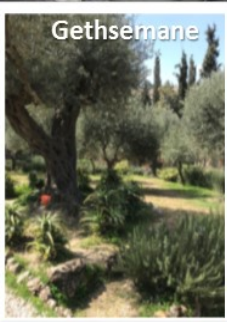

Join friends from Cedar Run as we retrace the path of the patriarchs and walk in the footsteps of Jesus. Together, we'll gain greater insight into the Scriptures and a new understanding of the land that Christ called home.

Highlights:

Sea of Galilee: We'll spend 4 nights on the Sea of Galilee, visiting Jesus' hometown of Nazareth, crossing the Sea of Galilee, praying on the Mt of Beatitudes, visiting Peter's home in Capernaum and Magdala's 1st century synagogue. There will be an opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River.

Dead Sea Region: We'll spend 2 nights on the incredible Dead Sea region, exploring ancient ruins, including Abraham's well, Herod's fortress, Goliath's strong hold and David's desert refuge.

Jerusalem: We'll spend 4 nights in Jerusalem experiencing the Garden of Gethsemane, the Temple Mount, and the Mount of Olives. We'll peek into caves that may have hosted the birth of Jesus, and visit the Upper Room, as the streets of Jerusalem bring to life the stories we learn in scripture.

Trip Cost

All-inclusive Israel Land Trip: \$4,100 per person, double occupancy
Add for single room: \$1,500

Includes deluxe lodging, meals, entrance to all sites, licensed Christian tour guides, transportation in deluxe large touring bus, all tips, trip insurance, airport transfers and a special farewell dinner. Virtually all expenses in Israel are included.

Does NOT include Airfare. The opportunity to fly together as a group will be available, and we are seeking a reduced group airfare from a mission-based travel service.

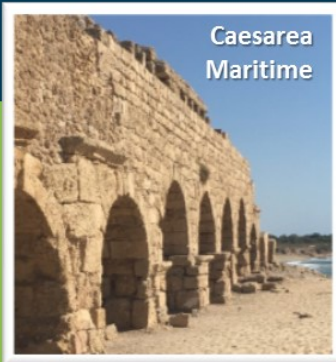
About our Guides

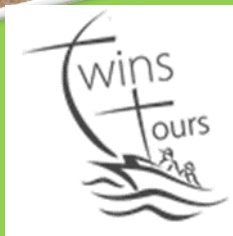

Each day will be filled with opportunities to explore the places Moses, Abraham, David and Jesus spent their days, and engage with scripture in a profoundly moving way. Here is a taste of our daily experiences:

Day 1: Saturday, Sept. 7th- Arrive in Israel & ride to Galilee

Arrive in Israel by 4 pm – Ben Gurion Airport (TLV)
Welcome Dinner & Overnight at a lovely hotel by the Sea of Galilee

Day 2: Sunday, Sept. 8th- Becoming a Disciple of Jesus

Visit the Mt. of Beatitudes- Sermon on the Mount, and Tabgha on shore of Galilee
Capernaum-Home town of Jesus” & boat ride on sea of Galilee
Dinner and Worship time & team sharing at hotel (every evening!)

Day 3: Monday, Sept. 9th- Via Maris- Road of the Sea

Mount Arbel , Megiddo-ancient site (Armageddon) and Mt Carmel
Caesarea Maritima- King Herod’s harbor, palace & theater

Day 4: Tuesday – Sept. 10th - Nazareth & Golan Heights

Golan Heights, Banias /Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan
Nazareth Village and Mt Precipice with Young Life Israeli staff
Baptism in the Jordan River (optional)

Day 5: Wed. Sept. 11th - Jericho and Judean Desert (Depart Galilee for Dead Sea Region)

Visit Magdala- a 1st century Galilee village and Bethany beyond the Jordan
Jericho and Qumran where dead sea scrolls were discovered

Day 6: Thurs. Sept. 12th - Dead Sea Area

Hike Ein Gedi to David’s Desert Oasis hiding place as he was hunted by Absalom
Explore Masada, King Herod’s desert fortress, and then Float in the Dead Sea

Day 7: Friday Sept. 13th - Beersheva to Jerusalem (Depart Dead Sea for Jerusalem)

Tel Arad, Ancient Canaanite City & Tel Sheva, Abraham’s Well
Elah Valley – battle of David vs. Goliath

Day 8: Sat. Sept. 14th - Welcome to Jerusalem & Bethlehem

Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane and Dominus Flevit Church;
Bethlehem’s Church of the Nativity traditional site of Jesus Birth & Shepherds Fields,

Day 9: Sunday Sept. 15th – Jerusalem of Jesus’ days

Temple Mount – early morning visit, if security conditions permit.
Pools of Bethesda, Antonia Fortress, Upper Room, Western Wall
Via Dolorosa to Holy Sepulchre Church- (Calvary/Golgotha), Kotel Tunnel Tour

Day 10: Monday, Sept. 16th – Early Jerusalem

City of David, Southern Steps & Hezekiah’s Tunnel, Garden Tomb
Farewell Dinner in Jaffa before late evening flights home
